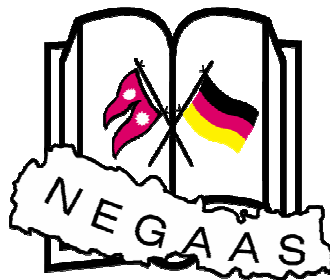
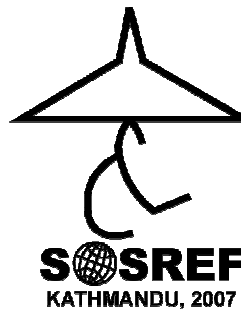

About the Program

On the occasion of Golden Jubilee Year of Nepal-German Diplomatic Relation, Nepal German Academic Association (NEGAAS), a forum of scholars educated in Germany dedicated to promoting bilateral academic relations, and Social Science Research Foundation (SOSREF), a non-profit distribution trust dedicated to the development of research culture in Nepal and the region, with support from DAAD Germany are Jointly conducting a three-day training-cum-workshop on 1-3 April, 2009 "Thinking like a social scientist: Learning Some Advance Research Tools and Publishing international Journal"

Research works of Nepalese social scientists are rarely published in standard international journals. The main obstacles in publishing research articles are the lack of proper knowledge on modern research tools and on research article writing skills.

Nepalese cultural diversity and its unique socio-political mosaic have attracted international scholars for collaborative cross-cultural research in social-sciences in Nepal. The planned training workshop is designed to empower Nepalese scholars in relevant research issues, modern tools of investigation and dissemination approaches to use their deep knowledge with the motto of turning information into knowledge and knowledge into wisdom.

Objective

The primary objective of the event is to motivate Nepali social scientists for using modern scientific research tools in their research works and publishing the results in international journals.

Methodology

Interactive lectures and presentations of principal resource person will be designed on Leadership, Identification, Prejudice, Contact, Discrimination and Inter-group behavior. Few Nepali social scientists will contextualize the theme with the help of participants' unique socio-political knowledge. Then, principal resource person will demonstrate the techniques of structural equation modeling and multi-modeling tools for theoretical research. Participative sessions will also be designed to share some approaches in theory building research, dissemination of the research findings, and promoting collaborative social science research.

Principal Resource Person

The program will be facilitated by the German Social Scientist Prof. Dr. Rolf van Dick, Associate Dean; Chair of Social Psychology, Institute of Psychology, Goethe University Frankfurt (Germany). He is the Editor-in-Chief of the British Journal of Management and the Journal of Personnel Psychology. His research interests and areas of specialization are social psychology, organizational behavior, leadership and management.
